

# Pench Tiger Reserve (PTR) of Maharashtra.

## **Key Points**

- About:
  - It is located in Nagpur District of Maharashtra and named after the pristine Pench
    - The Pench river flows right through the middle of the
    - It descends from north to south, thereby dividing the reserve into equal eastern and western
  - PTR is the **joint pride** of both **Madhya Pradesh** and
    - The Reserve is located in the southern reaches of the Satpura hills in the Seoni and Chhindwara districts in Madhya Pradesh, and continues in Nagpur district in Maharashtra as a separate
- It was declared a National Park by the Government of Maharashtra in 1975 and the identity of a tiger reserve was granted to it in the year 1998-1999.
- However, PTR Madhya Pradesh was granted the same status in 1992-1993.
  It is one of the major Protected Areas of Satpura- Maikal ranges of the Central
- It is among the sites notified as Important Bird Areas (IBA) of
- The IBA is a programme of Birdlife International which aims to identify, monitor and protect a global network of IBAs for conservation of the world's birds and associated diversity.
