

National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) - Formation

- 1. NCRB was set-up in 1986.
- 2. NCRB was formed by merging the Inter-State Criminals Data Branch, Directorate of Coordination and Police Computer (DCPC), and Central FingerPrint Bureau of CBI.
- 3. As part of NCRB evolution, the Crime and Criminal Tracking NetworkingSystem (CCTNS) was approved in 2009 and Digital Police Portal was launched in 2017.

National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) – Objectives

- 1. Maintain a national database of fingerprints of all criminals in India.
- 2. Create, lead, and coordinate the development of IT applications for Police.
- 3. Collate information and maintain statistics on crime and criminals at thenational level.
- 4. Creation and maintenance of Database at the National level for law enforcement agencies.
- 5. To coordinate, guide and assist the functioning of the State Crime Records Bureaux, along with, providing training facilities to personnel of the CrimeRecords bureaux
- 6. To function as the National storehouse of fingerprint (FP) records of convicted persons including FP records of foreign criminals
- 7. To keep the central and state governments updated with the official records and findings related to any case
