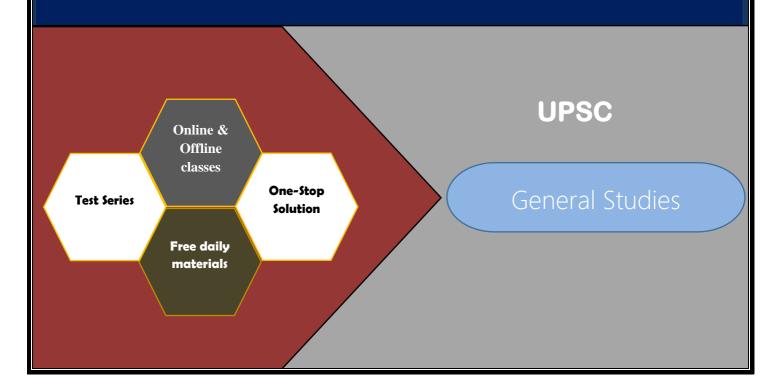

## Kyhytysuka Sachicarum: New Marine Reptile

Recently, an international team of researchers has discovered a **new marine reptile** named Kyhytysuka sachicarum.Key Points

- Kyhytysuka translates to 'the one that cuts with something sharp' in an indigenous language from the region in central Colombia where the fossilwas found.
- It has been **named so to honour the ancient Muisca culture** that existed therefor millennia.
- The fossil is a **stunningly preserved meter-long skull**, is one of the lastsurviving **ichthyosaurs** ancient animals that look eerily like living swordfish.

## o Ichthyosaur:

- They are the members of an extinct group of aquatic reptiles, most of which were **very similar to porpoises in appearance andhabits.**
- They had a **very wide geographic distribution**, and their fossilremains span almost the entire **Mesozoic Era.**
- They are first known from the **Triassic Period of Asia**, where they began as long-bodied, undulating swimmers without manyof the specializations seen in later species.
- The species comes from an **important transitional time during the Early Cretaceous period** when the Earth was coming out of a relatively cool period, had **rising sea levels**, and the supercontinent Pangea (A supercontinent that incorporated almost all the landmasses on Earth) was splitting into northern and southern landmasses.
