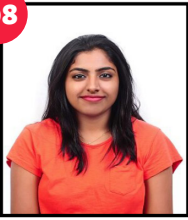

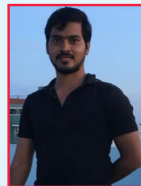

- The questions are likely **to test the candidate's** basic understanding of **all relevant issues**, and **ability to analyse**, and **take a view on** conflicting socio-economic goals, objectives and demands.
- The candidates **must** give relevant, meaningful and succinct answers.

Intellectual Standards

- The intellectual standards are the elements used to determine the quality of reasoning. Good critical thinking requires having a command of these standards.

The intellectual standards include:

Clarity

- Could you elaborate?
- Could you illustrate what you mean?
- Could you give me an example?

Accuracy

- How could we check on that?
- How could we find out if that is true?
- How could we verify or test that?

Precision

- Could you be more specific?
- Could you give me more details?
- Could you be more exact?

Relevance

- How does that relate to the problem?
- How does that bear on the question?
- How does that help us with the issue?

Depth

- What factors make this difficult?
- What are some of the complexities of this question?
- What are some of the difficulties we need to deal with?

Breadth

- Do we need to look at this from another perspective?
- Do we need to consider another point of view?
- Do we need to look at this in other ways?

Logic

- Does all of this make sense together?
- Does your first paragraph fit in with your last one?

Significance

- Is this the most important problem to consider?
- Is this the central idea to focus on?
- Which of these facts are most important?

Fairness

- Is my thinking justifiable in context?
- Am I taking into account the thinking of others?
- Is my purpose fair given the situation?
