# International Big Cat Alliance (IBCA)

- To provide a platform for “dissemination of information on benchmarked practices, capacity building, resources repository, research and development, awareness creation”, etc., on the protection and conservation of big cats.
- IBCA will work towards the protection and conservation of the seven major big cats.
- **7 big cats: Tiger, lion, leopard, snow leopard, puma, jaguar and cheetah.**
- After the import of Cheetah from Namibia, India is the only country in the world to have tigers, lions, leopards, snow leopards and cheetahs in the wild. o However, pumas and jaguars are not present in India



# Chip 4 Alliance

- It includes four of the world's top producers of semiconductors: the
- 1) U.S
- 2) Korea.
- 3) Japan
- 4) Taiwan
- It aims to enhance the "security" and "resilience" of semiconductor supply chains, including by reducing the world's reliance on chips made in China. o Basically, it is anti-China alliance.



# Monument Mitras.

- The Monument Mitras are selected by the 'oversight and vision committee,' co-chaired by the Tourism Secretary and the Culture Secretary.
- It is an initiative of the Ministry of Tourism, in collaboration with the Ministry of Culture and the Archaeological Survey of India.
- The government invites entities, including public sector companies, private sector firms as well as individuals, to develop selected monuments and heritage and tourist sites across India.

# INDIA'S FIRST RIGHT TO HEALTH LEGISLATION- Rajasthan's Right to Health Bill

- If the Bill is passed, the residents of the State will be eligible for free checkups, drugs, diagnostics, emergency transport and care at all public health institutes, along with affordable surgeries.
- aims to provide mandatory free and affordable medical services in both public and privately owned hospitals, clinics and laboratories.

## SALIENT FEATURES OF THE RIGHT TO HEALTH DRAFT BILL, RAJASTHAN

### OBLIGATIONS OF THE GOVERNMENT

- Appropriate state budget for health
- Within six months of enactment, develop and institutionalize a human resource policy for health for equitable distribution of healthcare workers across hospitals
- Social audit and grievance redressal mechanism
- Within one year, prescribing standards for quality and safety at all levels of hospitals
- Guarantee availability of government funded healthcare services as per distance or geographical area
- Ensuring that there is no direct or indirect denial to anyone for any government funded healthcare service
- Institute effective measures to prevent, treat and control epidemics and other public health emergencies
- Setting up state and district level health authorities

1) A group of 16 countries has launched a gallant effort to fight the problem of climate change at the United Nations (UN), Led by Vanuatu, an island country in the South Pacific Ocean, the group seeks an advisory opinion from the International Court of Justice (ICJ).

2) **The International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea (ITLOS)** has been requested to prevent, control, and reducing pollution of the marine environment.

3) The ITLOS is an independent judicial body established by the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea(UNCLOS) to adjudicate disputes arising out of the interpretation and application of the Convention.



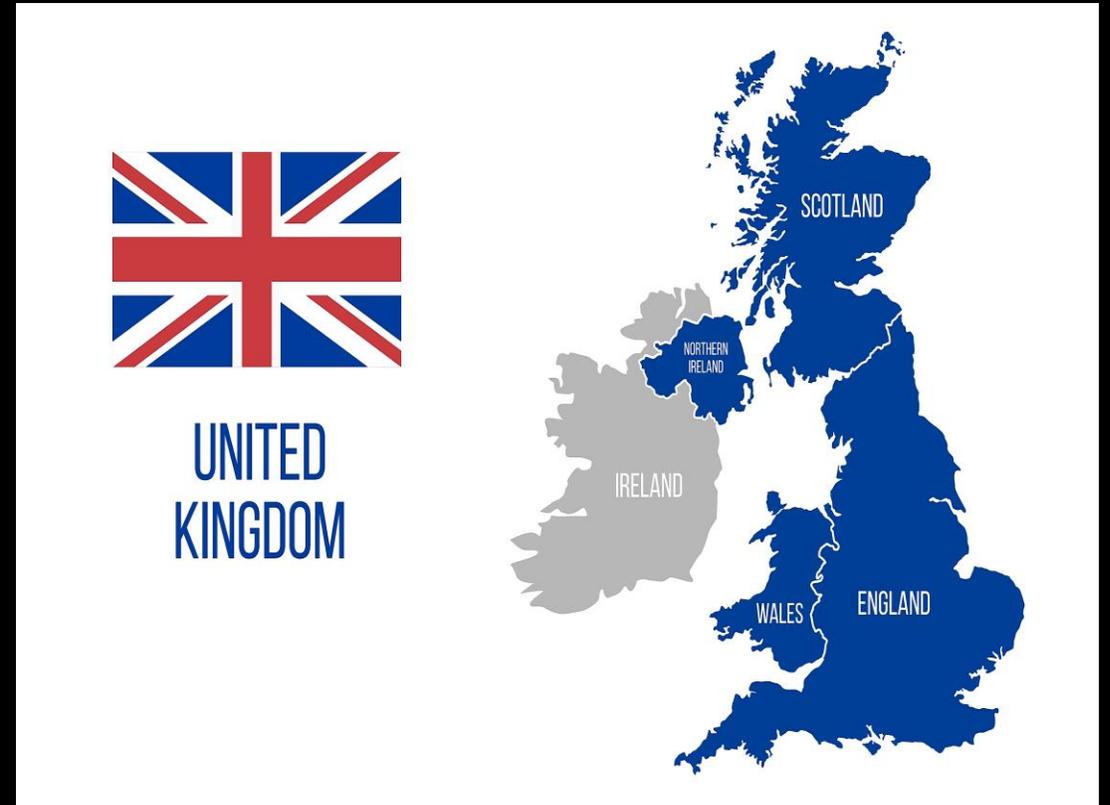

- The UK government reached a landmark deal with the European Union (EU) on post-Brexit trade rules related to governing the Northern Ireland.



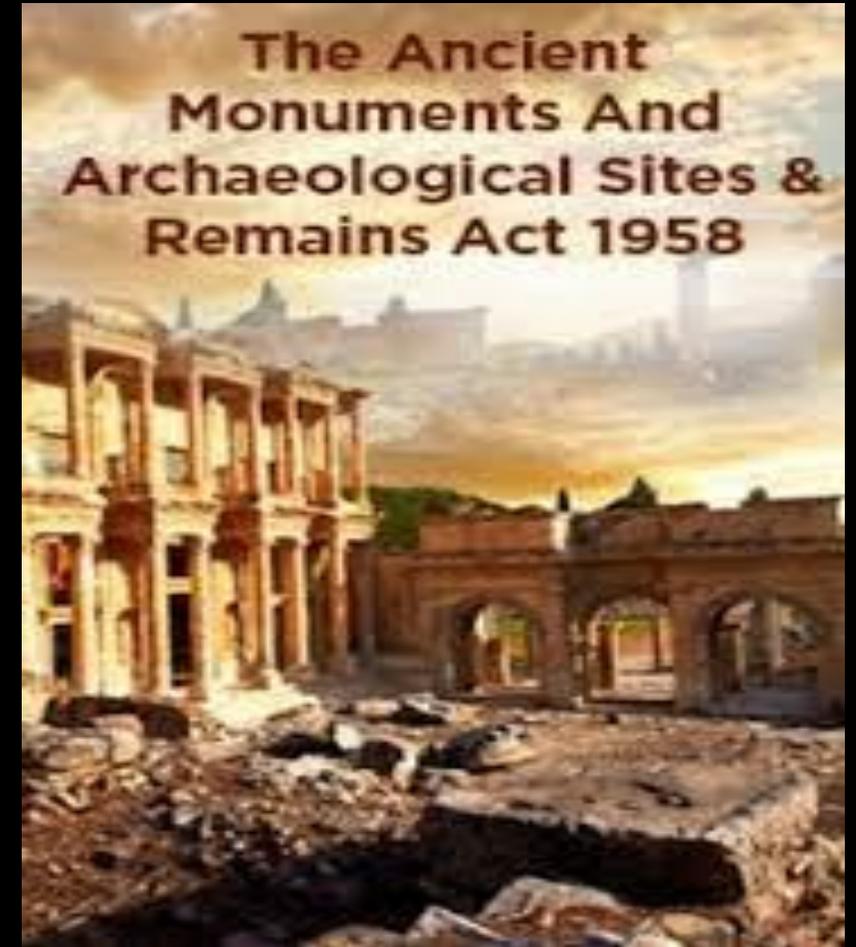
# Exercise Desert Flag

# Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains (AMASR) (Amendment) Bill

- Amendments includes, allowing the construction of public works in prohibited areas, and the approval and impact assessment of such public works.
- The original Act prohibits construction in an area of 100 metres around protected monuments, and the central government can extend this area beyond 100 metres.
- Now, the government will be allowed to take up infrastructure projects for public works in this prohibited area.

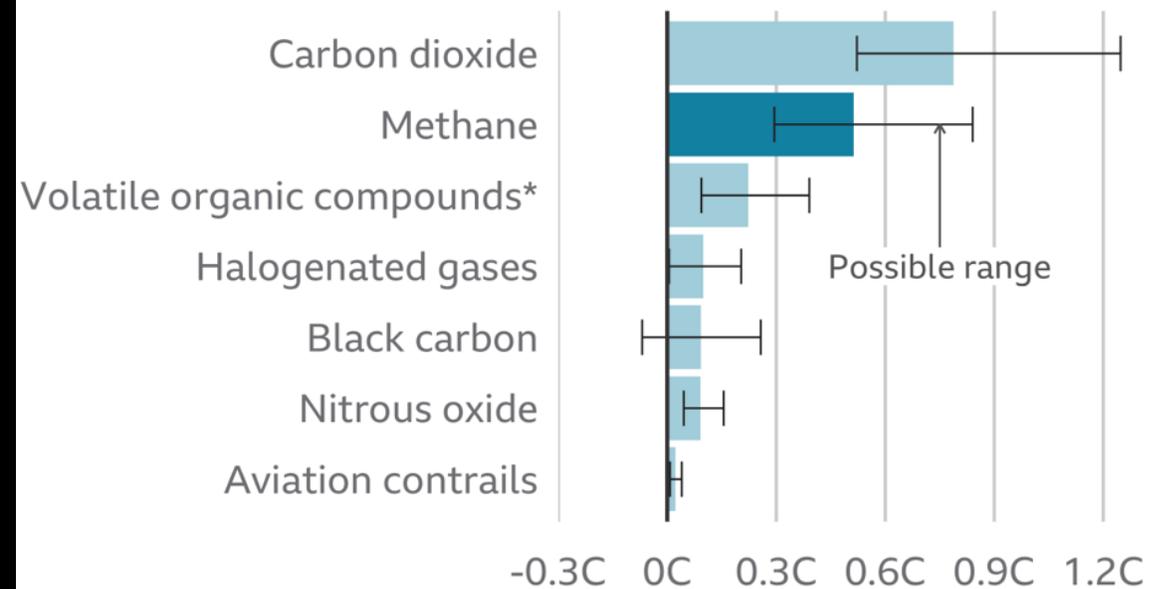

# Methane Global Tracker report

- The Methane Global Tracker report is the annual report released by the International Energy Agency.
- 40% of the methane emissions are from the energy sector.
- **Methane Initiatives**
- **Global Methane Pledge:**
- It was announced by the US and EU. It aims to reduce methane emissions by 30% in 2030 as compared to 2020.
- **MARS:** MARS is **Methane Alert and Response System**. It integrates data related to methane emissions. It was launched by the United Nations Environment Programme. It is a satellite-based monitoring programme.

  - Location: Waddington Air Force Base in **United Kingdom**
  - It is a multilateral Air exercise in which Air Forces from **Finland, Sweden, South Africa, United States of America and Singapore** would also be participating alongside **Royal Air Force** and Indian Air Force.

# CYBER CRIME:

- India reported nearly 52,974 cybercrime incidents in 2021 which was an increase of nearly 6% from 2020.
- Telangana was the state with the highest number of cybercrime cases, accounting for more than 19% of the total.
- Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka saw a decrease in the number of cybercrime cases by 20% and 24%, respectively.

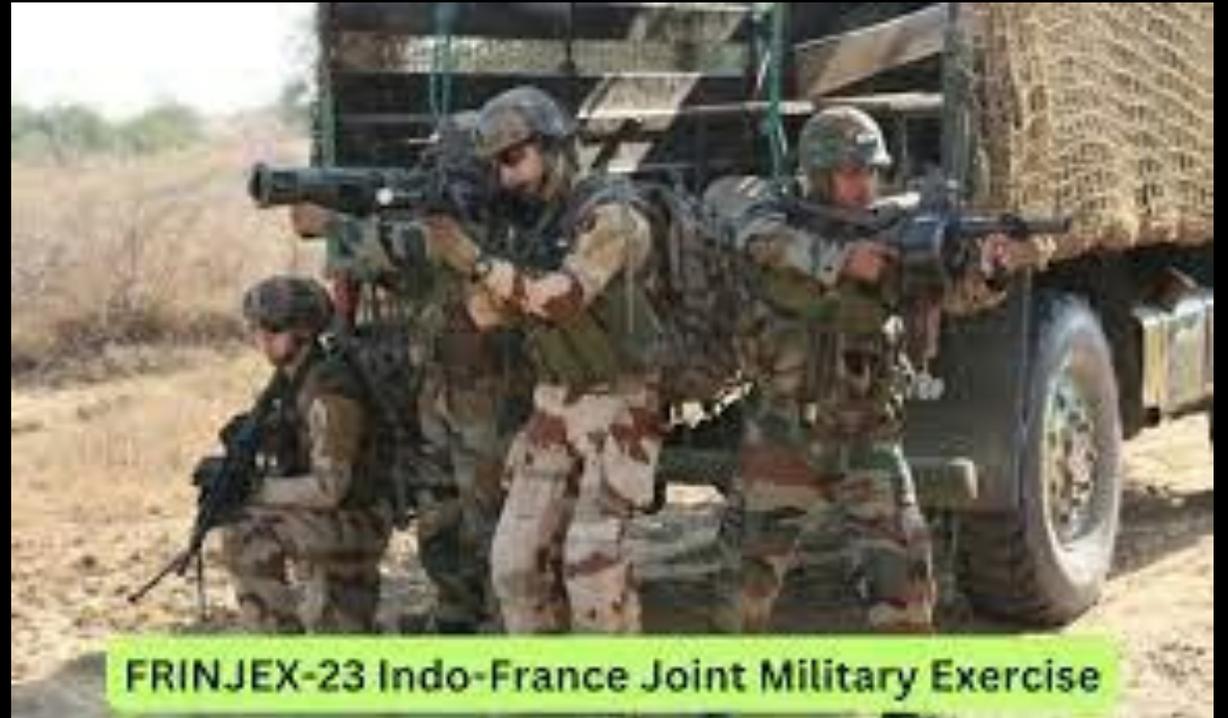

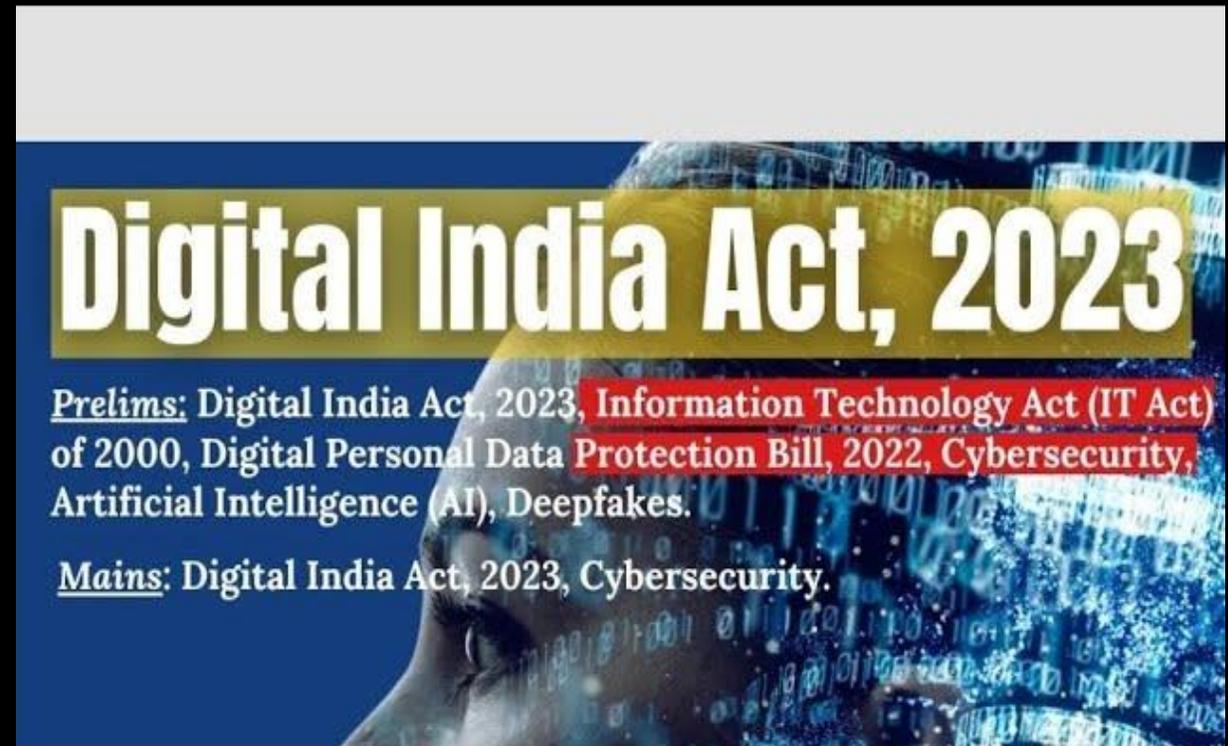
# FRINJEX-23
